In accordance with Article XV, Paragraph 3 of the BIG National Constitution, "Any member in good standing at the chapter, regional and national level may propose amendments to the National Constitution." Strongly encourage meeting with respective BIG members to receive input and participation. Your cooperation and active participation is appreciated.
